APPROVAL GRANTED TO OPEN GRADE 3 AND GRADE 7 ON MONDAY 1 JUNE 2020

The District Director of Gauteng North visited our School this afternoon to do inspection of our facilities. **Our School complies with all the regulations and has been approved to open for Grade 3 and Grade 7 on 1 June 2020.** Glory be to God! We are very relieved and excited to soon have our learners back at School.

Please make sure you carefully read all the information in the letters that were sent to you earlier this week. If you do not have a printer at home and you are not able to sign the Parent agreement documents, don't worry, we will provide your child with a hard copy as soon as your child is back at school. The signed agreement will need to be submitted on the following day to allow your child to continue attending School.

Upon arrival, all learners and staff will be temperature screened, hands will be sanitised, and masks will be checked. Learners or staff who record a fever of 38°C or above will not be allowed to attend the school day. The School will contact Parents to fetch a learner with a temperature immediately, to be tested for Covid-19. The learner or staff member may only return to school after submitting a medical certificate, testing negative for Covid-19.

VERY IMPORTANT: If you notice that your child has a fever or shows symptoms of Covid-19 at home, do not send him/her to school. Please first consult with a doctor or get your child tested. Report any suspicious COVID 19 symptoms or confirmed cases immediately to the School Office.

A few very important things to remember:

1. Masks:

- Your child **MUST** wear a **double layer cloth mask** on arrival. No mask, no entry.
- If you would like to buy an additional mask, it will be sold for R20 at the School. We will not provide any change as we limit working with cash. Please send the correct amount with your child should your child wish to buy a mask.
- Visors will be allowed, but only in addition to wearing a mask. No learner may come only with a visor.

2. School hours:

No visitors are allowed on property and no vehicles are allowed to drive through the gate. Please drop off your child at the gate.

Drop off: Please arrange for drop off between 07:30 – 07:55.

School hours: 08:00 – 12:30.

Pick up: Please arrange for pick up directly after school at 12:30. Please communicate with your transport service provider to fetch your child immediately to ensure the safety of your child.

3. Learner orientation:

On the first day of return, your child will receive orientation on Covid-19 as well as the new protocols and procedures at school. It is very important that your child attends this orientation, and we therefore request that you send your child on the day that he/she is scheduled to be back and not only a few days later.

4. Stationery:

Please check that your child has all the stationery that he/she needs. No sharing of stationery will be allowed.

5. Water bottles:

Please send a water bottle to school. Learners will not be allowed to drink from water fountains.
