### 2021 STATIONERY REQUIREMENTS

It is important for learners to have all the necessary stationery to ensure continued quality learning. Although it is advisable for items to be purchased by the start of the school year, items marked with an asterisk (\*) may be purchased per term. Supplies purchased at the start of the year can be safely stored by the teacher. You will be notified when your child's supplies are running low or need to be replaced. Parents/Caregivers are kindly requested to also check their child's pencil bag regularly to see if all the necessary stationery is there or if any items need to be stocked up.

**All items** (scissors, erasers, sharpeners, etc.) are to be clearly marked with the child's name before it is sent to school.

#### Books:

- Exercise books can be covered with paper of choice before it is covered with thick plastic.
- All books should be labelled with name stickers on top of the plastic, on the top right hand corner of the book.
- Exercise books should last each student a full year at school. If they lose their book or run out of space, teachers will alert parents to inform them that they need a new book.
- All textbooks need to be covered with thick plastic within the first two weeks of term 1.
- Learners should please keep the dictionaries that were used in grade 2 to also use in grade 3.
